



Foothold for residential construction in Czech Republic

- YIT bought 85% of Euro Stavokonsult s.r.o. - local management owns 15%
- Acquisition will combine the local contact network, expertise and market know-how of Euro Stavokonsult with YIT's housing concept
- Target to start up residential construction during spring 2009
- Company will concentrate on operations in Prague and its surroundings





Building system services expanded into Central Europe


- Acquisition of MCE's building system service operations in Germany, Austria, Poland, Czech Republic, Hungary and Romania

Total revenue: EUR 4,062 million



Total revenue: EUR 4,062 million




Acquisition rationale

- Change ongoing to improve profitability by increasing long-term service agreements and maintenance services
- Maintaining a balanced business structure by increasing low capital intensive services






Building Systems Track record of profitable growth










Building Systems after acquisition Revenue 2007 pro forma
